TRAVEL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CABRINI EMPLOYEES

Supported by the Medical Staff

\$1,000 travel scholarships (capped at \$20,000 annually) are available to foster the relationship between medical staff and other Cabrini clinical staff. These scholarships support junior-to-mid-level nursing, allied health and pharmacy staff to attend domestic (excluding metropolitan Melbourne) or international conferences *where they are presenting* by assisting with travel costs (i.e. flights and accommodation).

Up to <u>\$1,000</u> per recipient available

Key requirements include:

- Lodgement of applications at least 6 weeks prior to the event*
- A minimum 0.6FTE is required and at least 2 years continuous employment with Cabrini is preferred.
- The applicant must possess Australian citizenship or permanent residency.
- Confirmation of abstract acceptance from the conference organisers for a poster or oral presentation of a Cabrini research or quality project. Consideration will be given to applicants who have been invited as a guest speaker or to run a workshop.
- A detailed dissemination of knowledge plan approved by the applicant's manager
- Disclosure of additional funding received by another source (within Cabrini or externally) towards attendance at this conference.
- Demonstration of personal financial contribution towards costs. A maximum of 50% of the registration fees may be funded by the scholarship and the balance by the recipient.
- For travel scholarships, all bookings for hotels/accommodation, rental vehicles, airline, intercity and ferry tickets must be made with Cabrini's corporate travel agent, FCM Travel Solutions via a Cabrini Travel Coordinator.
